### 1. LEADERSHIP AND TEAMWORK VIDEO PROJECT

- 1.1. This is a team competition and is open to students from the ages of 12 – 18.
- 1.2. Each team should consist five members from the same school who will carry out the project together.
- 1.3. Each team can only submit ONE video project.
- 1.4. The completed video will be presented during G-Lead Session in Malaysia.
- 1.5. The video should be in English and the duration of the video is between 3 – 4 minutes.
- 1.6. The video prepared can take the form of one or all of the following:
  - 1.6.1. Documentary
  - 1.6.2. Motivational challenge
  - 1.6.3. Short story
- 1.7. The video should promote leadership in the following aspects:
  - 1.7.1. What is leadership?
  - 1.7.2. The habits or characteristics of a great leader.
  - 1.7.3. The importance of teamwork and leadership.
  - 1.7.4. How leaders promote and manage their team.
  - 1.7.5. How students or young people can start playing leadership roles locally and globally.
- 1.8. The team should avoid sensitive or harmful issues that show disrespect towards or ridicule any religion or nation.
- 1.9. The video should be uploaded to the **YOUTUBE** or **FACEBOOK**.
- 1.10. The **VIDEO LINK** from the YOUTUBE or FACEBOOK should then be submitted to the Organizing Committee by email ([info@myglead.com](mailto:info@myglead.com)) **before April 1, 2024**, for preliminary evaluation and final judging of the project will be carried out during G-Lead Session in Malaysia.

### 2. G-LEAD IN ACTION: FIELD WORK PROJECT

- 2.1. This is a team competition and is open to students from the ages of 12 – 18.
- 2.2. Each team should consist of five members from the same school who will carry out the project together.
- 2.3. Each team can only submit ONE field work project.
- 2.4. The completed project will be presented in English during G-Lead Session in Malaysia.
- 2.5. Each team should prepare for an oral presentation during G-Lead Session, when required.
- 2.6. The project report should comprise a **PowerPoint Presentation** (8 – 10 slides) as a compulsory submission and at least three of the following forms of presentations/evidences:
  - 2.6.1. Video evidence of the field work project while it is being carried out (2 – 3 minutes)
  - 2.6.2. Posters (A2 Size)

- 2.6.3. Booklets (No fixed format)
  - 2.6.4. Photo Gallery (No fixed format)
  - 2.6.5. Relevant Model(s) built from recycle materials
- 2.7. What your team should do:
- 2.7.1. Identify a problem or issue that exists within your school or community.
  - 2.7.2. Study and understand the specific issue or problem.
  - 2.7.3. Identify the role your team could play in addressing the problem or issue.
  - 2.7.4. Work together to overcome the problem or issue, or at least address part of the problem or issue.
  - 2.7.5. Compile the whole project for presentation.
- 2.8. During G-Lead Session, each team will be provided a small area with a table to display and promote their project. Display board will not be provided, so each team will have to decide how their materials will be displayed. Your team may also display information about your team, school and country. You may also prepare souvenirs to exchange with other participants.
- 2.9. All presentation material will be in English.
- 2.10. **ONLY PowerPoint presentation** (in slide show format) should be submitted to the Organizing Committee by email ([info@myglead.com](mailto:info@myglead.com)) **before April 1, 2024**, for preliminary evaluation and final judging of the project will be carried out during face-to-face G-Lead Session in Malaysia.

### 3. LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE

- 3.1. This is a team competition and is open to students from the ages of 12 – 18.
- 3.2. Each team should consist of four - six members assigned by the Organizing Committee during G-Lead Session.
- 3.3. Each team will take part in three to four leadership activities and compete with other teams.
- 3.4. Each team will work together, during each activity, to collect as many scores as possible to emerge as winner.

### 4. LEADERSHIP QUIZ

- 4.1. This is a challenge for individual student of the ages between 12 – 18.
- 4.2. Participants will answer quizzes based on Leadership Training Session and other activities during G-Lead Session in Malaysia.
- 4.3. Those with the highest scores are selected as winners.
- 4.4. Should there be a tie, extra set of questions will be given to those with the same scores.

### 5. BEST GLOBAL LEADER (MALE AND FEMALE)

- 5.1. For every activity and competition, participants will receive team and individual scores.
- 5.2. Each team score will also be recorded as individual score.
- 5.3. The highest total score for male and female participants will determine the winners for BEST GLOBAL LEADER AWARDS.
